

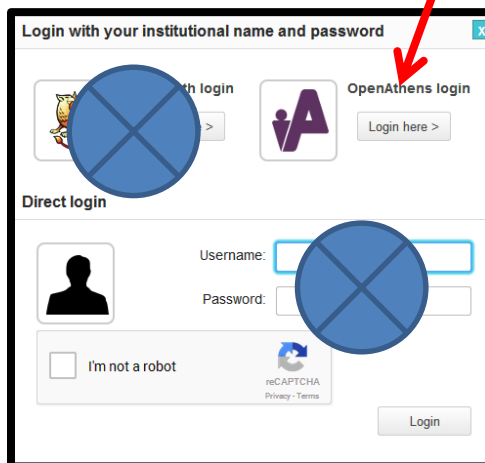
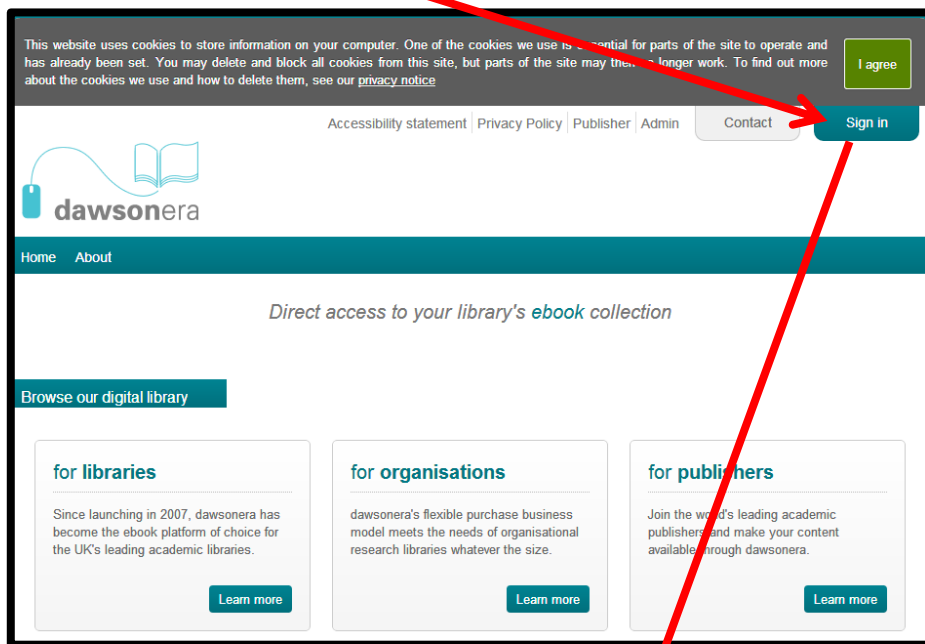

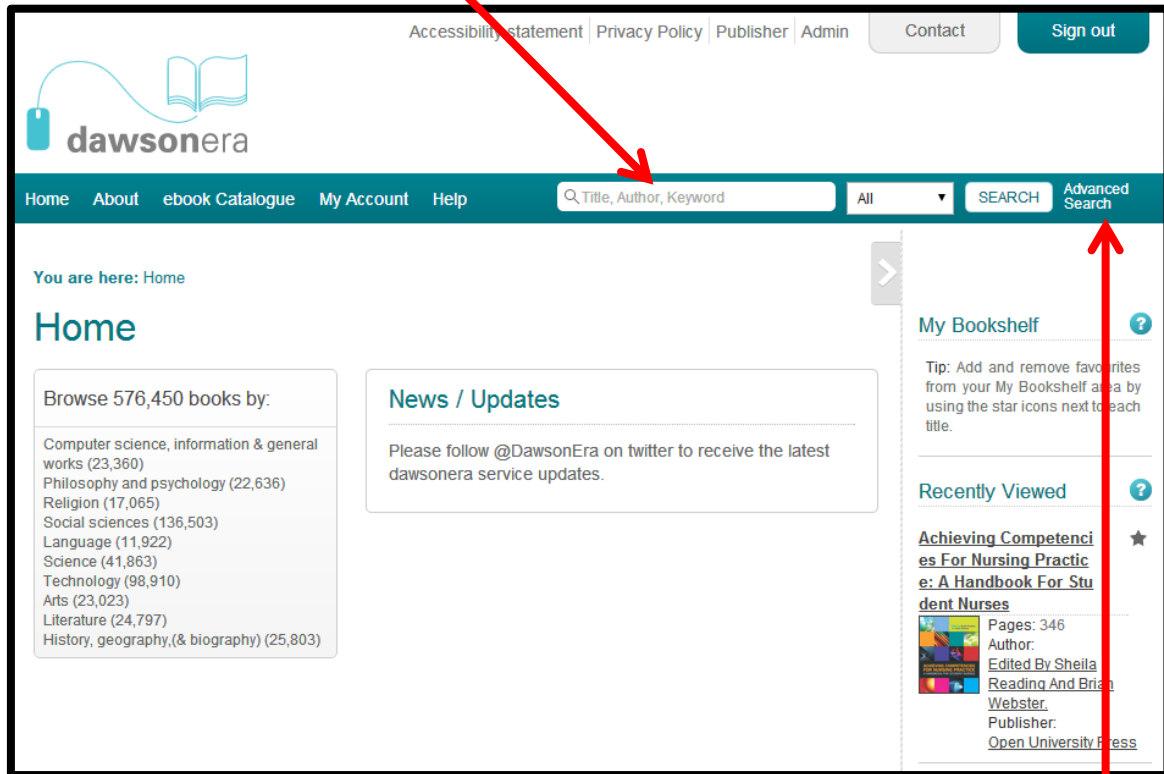

Options for accessing Unowned content:

**Browse options (from the Home screen):**

**ebook Catalogue** – a list of the ebooks you have access to (Owned by my library)

**Browse 576,450 books by** – the complete list of ebooks available. Choose a category and then use the options on the left to refine your results. Choose **Technology** for Medical sciences and Management.
