11	<p>Background required when viewed in High and Soft Contrast Home page footer</p> <p>Difficult to discern the various input boxes as there is no background within both High and Soft Contrasts.</p> 	<p>Functionality</p>

12	<p>Placement has insufficient contrast when on focus in High Contrast Home page</p>  <p>Yellow font on a turquoise background has insufficient contrast when viewed in High Contrast when on focus.</p>	Fail SC 1.4.3 AA
13	<p>Meaningless repeated links on a page https://www.gmmh.nhs.uk/research-takingpart</p> <p>These links are meaningless when read out of context by a blind screen reader user.</p>  <p>An ARIA label should be added to block items that are repeated in order that blind screen reader users will hear a different description for each of these. In this example the "Learn More" buttons could state the heading text within the ARIA label attribute.</p>	Fail SC 2.4.4 A
